

Drop-In Support

My Home Drop-In Support services are designed to support individuals who live in their own, or family home, have transitioned to, or who want to transition to, more independent living arrangements.

Drop-In Support facilitates independent living by:

- Providing assistance with daily tasks such as cooking and cleaning
- Offering in-home care
- Facilitating community access
- Increasing social connections
- Supporting the management of health and wellbeing

Our qualified support staff provide supports in the person's own home, where they are most comfortable. The services are NDIS registered and funded through an NDIS Plan.

Group and Community Homes

Group and community homes allow people with disability to live together in a comfortable, social home environment, with skilled support staff on hand 24 hours a day.

Achieve Australia is dedicated to creating innovative disability accommodation solutions. Our group homes are fully accessible, comfortable and SDA approved.

Our group homes are designed or modified for people with disability and allow us to cater to diverse support needs.

People living in group homes have access to:

- 24-hour onsite support from qualified staff
- Comfortable living areas and outdoor spaces
- Medical and health support services
